



The meeting was called to order at 5:00 PM by Board President, Carley Young. Bob Hagenow led the Pledge of Allegiance.

This meeting was properly posted in the District.

Roll Call: Carley Young, Tammy Wakeman, Beth Laufenberg, Jordan Noyes and Keith Desjarlais. Also present were Superintendent Dr. Michael Lichucki; Director of Business Services Paula Glaser; Athletic Director Jared Napralla; and Administrative Assistant Nicole Bagwell.

Recognition of Visitors. There were two visitors present.

Approve Minutes from the December 15, 2025, Regular Board of Education Meeting. A motion was made by Keith Desjarlais and seconded by Jordan Noyes to approve the December 15, 2025, regular meeting minutes, as presented. Motion carried by a voice vote; five votes yes.

Rio Showcase - National FFA Convention. Agriculture teacher, Mrs. Andi Dohm, along with six students updated the board about the National FFA Convention that they attended. It went really well and they learned a lot.

Action Items

A. Bills for Payment. A motion was made by Tammy Wakeman and seconded by Beth Laufenberg to approve Checks, ACH, and Wire payments from 12/1/25 - 12/31/25 totaling \$643,727.94, as presented. Motion carried by a voice vote; five votes yes.

B. Human Relations





The Rio House

Rio was platted in 1864 by N.B. Dunlap. The first commercial lot was sold to Jacob Ulrich, who erected a hotel – The Rio House. It opened in December of 1865. This is East Rio Street looking West toward the railroad tracks. It is in the area where Steve's Auto is currently located. We believe this photo is from about 1899. The Rio House burned down and was rebuilt. Most of the buildings were consumed by fire at one time or another prior to 1904 when the Village passed an ordinance that all commercial buildings had to be built of brick and the main business district moved to Lincoln Avenue.


